- **2. February 2021:** On 21st February 2021, the Government of Assam appointed Prof. Jyoti Prasad Saikia as the first Vice Chancellor of the Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya (BSSRV), Golaghat. The Vishwavidyalaya is functioning till July, 2023 only with the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor without the appointment of a single regular staff/faculty.
- **3. March 2021:** The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor established the temporary office of the Vishwavidyalaya in the campus of the Golaghat Engineering College, Bogorijeng, Golaghat Assam. Expressing their goodwill, the Chutiya Development Council donated all the furniture required for establishment of the Vice Chancellor's office. In the meantime, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the Vishwavidyalaya prepared the Statutes to make the Vishwavidyalaya functional and got necessary cabinet approval.
- **4. June 2021:** The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor take up the matter for allotment of land for the permanent Campus of the Vishwavidyalaya with the Government of Assam and because of his constant efforts, the Government of Assam allotted 120 Bighas of land in Rangajan under Morongi Revenue Circle of Golaghat District for the permanent Campus of the University.
- **5.** Due to constant efforts of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, the Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya, Golaghat was granted 2 (f) Status by the University Grants Commission vide letter No F-9-19/2021 (CPP-I/PU) dated 28 March 2022 as a State University and is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 at its own departments.
- **6.** The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor planned out and finalized the entire blue print for construction of the permanent Campus of the Vishwavidyalaya. Government of Assam has released an amount of 63.5 Cr. for initial construction phase and after completion of required formalities, construction of the building is already started.
- **7. July 2022:**TheHon'ble Vice Chancellor constituted different Statutory Bodies of the Vishwavidyalaya i.e., Court, Executive Council, Finance Committee, Academic Council, Research Council under the provisions of the Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya Act, 2020 with the approval of the appropriate Authority. Till date, 3 (three) Executive Council, 1 (one) Finance Committee, 2 (two) Academic Council and 2 (two) Research Council meetings have been conducted.
- **8.** The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor under the provisions of the University Act and Statutes prepared Ordinances, Regulations and all other required policies as below and subsequently approved in the Executive Council:

Finance Rule

Teachers Service Conditions

Employees Service Conditions

Ordinances for Research Programmes

Ordinance on Post Graduate Study, etc.

- **9. October 2022:** The Vishwavidyalaya has started offering the PhD. Programme as per the UGC guidelines in collaboration with nearby colleges affiliated to the Dibrugarh University. During the Academic session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 total 05 (five) and 24 (twenty four) Research Scholars respectively were enrolled in PhD programme of the Vishwavidyalaya. Department wise monitoring Committee with external experts has been constituted to closely monitor and advice academic as well as research activities of PhD scholars admitted to the University.
- **10.** The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor submitted proposal to the Government of Assam for approval to create 16 (Sixteen) Academic departments at the Vishwavidyalaya. Subsequently, the Government of Assam has approved the creation of 11 (Eleven) Academic departments, namely Assamese, English, Political Science, Sociology, Economics, Computer Science, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, Chemistry and Physics. However, due to space constraint, the University has decided to start academic programmes of 6 (six) departments, i.e. Assamese, English, Political Science, Sociology, Economics, Computer Science, initially from the Academic Session 2022-2023.
- 11. July 2023: Against proposal submitted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor for creation of teaching and non teaching Posts as per the requirement for the status of 12 (b) under the UGC Act., the Government of Assam sanctioned 71 Posts (55 teaching and 16 non teaching). Out of the total sanctioned Posts, the Vishwavidyalaya advertised for 35 teaching and Non-teaching posts to cater the need for running 6 (six) academic departments initially vide the Advertisement No. BSSRV/VC/2022-23/ dated 10-03-2023. The advertisement was published in 2 (two) national and 3 (three) vernacular news papers. Due to huge response received from the Candidates, written test was conducted for short listing of candidates with the help of nearby Colleges and Dibrugarh University. Against the recruitment process, 18 (Eighteen) faculty members and 14 (Fourteen) non-teaching employees joined at the Vishwavidyalaya during July-August, 2023.
- 12. The Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya (BSSRV) continuing its academic activities since its inception with the initiative of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and support from other academic Institutes. So far, the Vishwavidyalaya organized 8 (Eight) National Seminars, 2(One) International Seminars and 4 (four) talks in collaboration with Dispur College; Gargaon College; Kamar Gaon College; JDSG College, Bokakhat; Jhanji Hemnath Sarma College; Margherita College; Amguri College and Dibrugarh University.

The Publication Cell of the Vishwavidyalaya published a book entitled "A History of the Chutiyas" written by Sri Prasanta Kumar Chutia with donation from Sri Saurabh Jyoti Saikia, APS.

13. A temporary Library and a Computer Laboratory has been set up at the temporary Campus of the Vishwavidyalaya for use of Faculty members and Students.

- **14. August 2023:** Admission to 5 (five) Post Graduate programmes in the Department of English, Assamese, Sociology, Political Science and Economics has been completed. The Hon'ble Governor of Assam and Chancellor of the Vishwavidyalaya gave his kind consent to inaugurate the Post Graduate Classes of the University on 5th September, 2023. A total number of 35 seats were allotted to each department, out of which 3 seats were reserved for transgender.
- **15. August 2023:** The Board of Studies of all academic departments of the Vishwavidyalaya has been constituted and syllabus for the upcoming Post Graduate programmes has been finalized.
- **16.** With a vision to provide opportunity for developing life skill of stakeholders, the Vishwavidyalaya initiated to start certificate courses in Creative Literature, Political Leadership, Anchoring, Tourist Guide, Graphics Design and Web Development, Python Programming and System Administration using Linux, the curriculum for each of the Course has been approved by the concerned Statutory Bodies.
- 17. The Vishwavidyalaya also plans to prepare the students for various competitive examinations and to proper execute the vision, a Centre for Competitive Examination shall be established at the Vishwavidyalaya. Further, a Centre for Study shall be introduced within a period of 5 (five) years for advance study on forest ecology, effect of surroundings on animal habitats, tourist management, biosphere reserve and its sustainable conservation, scientific way of prevention of illicit activities such as poaching and trafficking etc. Likewise, a Centre for International Affairs shall also be planned at the Vishwavidyalaya in order to collaborate with other academic institutions abroad.
- **18.** Total 6 (six) students cleared NET examination within a period of 6 months of their joining at the Vishwavidyalaya.
- **19.** The Intellectual Property Office of the United Kingdom (UK) has registered and granted design (patent) to Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya (BSSRV), Golaghat and certified to following Faculty members:
 - (a) Dr. Rubul Kumar Bania, Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science Certified on October 17, 2023 for the product design entitled, "Pesticide Spraying Drone with Integrated Crop Disease Detection System" bearing the design number 6318123.
 - (b) Dr. Pranjit Das, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science Certified on December 13, 2023 for the product design entitled, "IOT Enabled Respiratory Sensing Device", bearing the design number 6329015.
 - (c) Dr. Uzzal Sharma, Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science Certified on December 13, 2023 for the product design entitled, "IOT Based Camera for Health Care Management bearing the design number 6325088.
- **20**. Mr. Yankee Dowerah, PS to the Vice Chancellor and his team was awarded with the Best Short Feature Film Award 2023 named, "The

	Yellow Rose" by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.

BUDGET (ESTIMATE) FOR 2024-25

The Budget estimate for 2024-25 is a Deficit one which has been prepared taking the anticipated receipts from the State Govt. and internal resources for Rs. 13.7014 crore and the expenditure for Rs. 13.8814 crore. So the Deficit comes to Rs. 0.18 Crore.

While estimating the total receipts, the State Govt. Grant-in-Aid has been taken as Rs. 6.0720 crore being the Grant in Aid against salary component of BSSRV. And as per the ongoing trend receipts from the University's own sources has been estimated at Rs. 0.30 crore.

To meet the deficit of Rs. 0.18 Crore effort will be made to generate additional fund from own sources to some extent.

On the basis of the anticipated (estimated) receipt from all sources and considering the actual expenditure during the year 2022-23 and last year's estimate the expenditure has been projected covering the different Academic and Administrative Departments at Rs. 13.7014 crore, which are broadly classified as under:-

The Receipt & Expenditure under broad classification for the financial year 2024-25 have been estimated as follows:

Receipts:-
