


Minutes of the Meeting

The Registrar and Secretary, executive council, Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya, Mrs Orpah Baglary, welcomed the members and requested the Honourable Vice Chancellor, Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya, Professor Jyoti Prasad Saikia to take the chair and Prof. Jyoti Prasad Saikia responded her request immediately.

Item 1: Welcome Address by the Chairperson, Executive Council (EC).

The Secretary requested the hon'ble chairperson to deliver the welcome address. The Hon'ble Chairperson welcomed the members of the Executive Council. The chairperson appealed the council to confirm the minutes of the first meeting of the Executive Council that was held on 12 November 2021. The minutes of the first meeting were read out by the honourable chairperson. The Chancellor's nominee Prof. Amit Choudhury requested that the minutes be circulated beforehand or through email to all the members. The members accepted the proposal of confirmation of the minutes. After discussion, the members in its meeting unanimously supported and proposed to confirm the minutes. The minutes have been confirmed.

Item 2: The action taken report was read out by the honourable Vice-Chancellor.

The Vice-Chancellor pointed out that after joining he approached the government to provide needful support so that the University can become quickly functioning and received support from the Govt. of Assam to work properly considering the mission and vision of the University. The Chairperson placed the action report as per agenda.

The first action that was taken that inspite of economic hardship and lack of manpower an initiative had been taken to open a website and ultimately a University website was opened. The address of the website is www.bssrv.ac.in. The Chairperson noted that the website has been running seamlessly. The chairperson also informed that all notifications of the University have been published in website till date.

The second action placed by the Chairperson that a proposal has been submitted to the government for teaching and non-teaching posts to be sanctioned. The Hon'ble Vice-Chairperson noted that in response to his continuous efforts and approaches the Government of Assam created total 71 posts (16 non-teachings and 55 teaching) for the smooth functioning of the University. After receiving the sanctioning the letter from the government of Assam the chairperson constituted a committee for maintaining roster point reservation and an advertisement has been published accordingly. In light of this, hon'ble chairperson expressed his heart felt gratitude to the government of Assam for sanctioning 71 teaching and non-teaching posts. Out of these 16 are non-teaching and 55 are teaching posts, the chairperson decided to appoint all officers, but not to appoint all teaching faculty members. It was decided that initially, only six departments are to be commenced from the session 2023-24 and rest of others i.e. 5 science departments that are Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry



,Botany and Zoology will be started from the session 2024-2025 while spaces for class room and laboratory facilities would be available. The advertisement was published for appointment of six professors, 12 associate professors, 12 assistant professors, and one Assistant library for six department's i.e Assamese, English, sociology, political science, economics and computer science. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also apprised that remaining would be started in the next session. In this context initiation of the selection process would be taken after eight months. After advertising the various posts, the chairperson constituted a high power committee headed by Prof. Mrinalendu Narayan Dutta, former Registrar of Dibrugarh University. The chairperson also informed the members that for a total number of 44 posts both teaching and non-teaching over 600 applications were received. It was also noted that for shortlisting candidates written and screening tests were also held for certain posts i.e. Deputy Registrar (Administration), Deputy Controller of Examination, PA to VC, Assistant Librarian, Accountant, Account Assistant, Office Assistant, Junior Assistant and Peon. Considering priority of subject, it was also decided that post of Librarian is to be vacant for a couple of years. The chairperson expressed that in consultation with the concerned authorities he constituted a strong selection committee for selecting the best candidates and significantly the interviews were held smoothly without any contervence from 18th June to 28th June 2023. The chairperson expressed his gratitude to all those who provided countless assistance, suggestion and cooperation directly or indirectly. He specially offered gratitude to the Dibrugarh University for all holistic supports.

The third action that was taken by the Vice Chancellor that a publication cell was set up. It was noted that significantly, a book on the history of Chutiya Dynasty has been published and book was released by the Hon'ble Education Minister; Assam Dr Ronuj Pegu at Guwahati. The book was written by Dr Pasanta Kumar Chutia (konwerpur, Sivsagar, Assam) and provided financial support by Mr Sauravjyoti Saikia, APS on behalf of the University. The chairperson expressed his gratitude to both of them for their contribution. The chairperson also expressed that the publication cell will have have to publish a good number of quality books in near future. The members of the Executive Council suggested the chairperson to constitute a publication board with at least 6 reputed members of concerned domain.

The fourth action report has been placed by the chairperson that efforts are ongoing to sign MoUs and avail scholarships for research scholars. It was noted that six seminars have already been held in collaboration with colleges of Assam. An international seminar was also held by the University in collaboration with Dispur College and Swarnalipi. The seminars produced a substantial outcome to the concerned knowledge domain. The chairperson also informed that a symposium will be organized by the University in the last of November, 2023 under the auspices of Sahitya Academy.

The next action was taken that with a temporary office of the Vice-Chancellor at the Golaghat Engineering Institute was established. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor apprised that more space will be required for classrooms in order to start the academic session. The EC entrusted the Vice Chancellor with the responsibility to take the matter forward. The Governor's nominee at this point asked whether the post of the academic Registrar has been advertised. The honourable



Vice Chancellor responded that this post has not been sanctioned. The governor's nominee pointed out that it was important to have an academic Registrar as there was a need to implement NEP 2020 in the University. The members of Executive Council advised the Vice-Chancellor that until an Academic Registrar is appointed, the Controller of Examinations is to be given additional charge to discharge the duties of the Academic Registrar and to give him the responsibility to implement NEP 2020 in the University. The Controller of Examination will have to look after the all academic matters as directed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. In this context, the following resolution has been taken:

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1: "It is resolved that the Controller of Examination is to be given additional charge of Academic Registrar and he will have to initiate for implementation of NEP2020 properly."

Item 3: Appointment of officers, non-teaching staff and teaching staff.

Honourable Vice Chancellor placed the selected list of candidates for all the posts in front of the members of the Executive Council along with the list of marks and resolutions that the selection committee had prepared for each candidate. The Executive Council approved the candidates who were selected by the respective selection committee. The Executive Council suggested that the Registrar shall issue the Appointment Letters to the selected candidates after ending the meeting of Executive Council. It was suggested that all selected non-teaching candidates will be directed to attend seven days orientation training at Dibrugarh University before associating with the activities of Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya, Golaghat, Assam. The Executive Council directed the Registrar to submit the budget proposal to DHE in no time.

The Executive Council resolved that the panel for Office Assistants, Junior Assistants and Peons will be valid for up to two years and this will be applicable even if a candidate joins and decides to leave within two years. The Vice-Chancellor has been entrusted by the Executive Council with the responsibility to appoint candidates from the panel in case of selected candidates will not join or decided to leave after joining within a period of two years.

Item 4: Start Academic Session from August 2023.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor placed the proposal before Executive Council that two year Post-Graduate programme will be started for coming session. The Executive Council agreed to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor's proposal to start the academic session from August 2023 with minimum 25 students in the Arts departments and 15 in Computer Science. The Executive Council also suggested to follow the same syllabus of Dibrugarh University for the first four semesters. In this regard, the following resolution has been taken:

RESOLUTION NUMBER 34: "It is resolved that the two years post graduate programmes in five departments, ie Assamese, English, Sociology, Political Science and Economics, will be started by the University from the session 2023-2024. In addition, post Graduate diploma and certificate course will be started in the department of computer science."

Item 5: Appointment of staff on adhoc /contract basis/Casual

The chairperson expressed that some of casual workers will be needed for functioning the University and appealed the council to permit him to appoint casual and contractual staff if necessary. The Executive Council entrusted the Vice-Chancellor with the responsibility to appoint 4th-grade workers under the nomenclature of multiple task workers in a casual manner as required. In light of this a resolution has been taken as follow.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 35:

"It is resolved that the Vice-Chancellor is given permission to appoint Multiple Task Workers as required in the University"



Item 6: University Anthem.

The Executive Council approved the anthem for the University with lyrics by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Jyoti Prasad Saikia and music by Dr Anil Saikia. The Executive Council appreciated Prof. Jyoti Prasad Saikia for his lyrics. The members opined that the mission and vision of the University is clearly depicted in the lyric and it means true indication of the motto of Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya. Hon'ble members Prof. Sushma Yadav and Prof. Amit Choudhury opined that tune of anthem should be simple and melodious. The Executive Council resolved that the all stakeholders must respect the Anthem and dis-regard the University Anthem is punishable. The Executive Council accepted that the anthem of 2:15 minutes is to be sung on formal occasions and that it may be shortened to a 1.5-minute duration that is to be played every day in the university premises. In this context the following resolution has been taken:

Item 7: Purchasing and outsourcing vehicles of the Vice-Chancellor and Registrar.

Hon'ble Chairman appraised the availability and necessity of the vehicle for Vice-Chancellor and Registrar and the Executive Council entrusted the Vice-Chancellor with the responsibility to purchase or outsource the vehicles as required. In this regard, the following resolution has been taken:

RESOLUTION NUMBER 37:

"It is resolved that the Vice Chancellor is entrusted responsibility to purchase or out source the vehicles for University, i.e. Vehicle of Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and others. The expenditure will be debited from the office expenses of the Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya, Golaghat, Assam"

Item 8: Temporary Campus.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor proposed that if the Government allow the Golaghat Engineering College, Golaghat, Assam for the establishment of the University temporarily, it should be convenient for smooth functioning of the University. The Executive Council approved the temporary campus of the University to be located at the Golaghat Engineering College, Golaghat, Assam. In this regard a resolution has been taken as follows:

RESOLUTION NUMBER 38:

"It is resolved that the Vice Chancellor is entrusted responsibility to initiate for establishment of the University in the Golaghat Engineering College premises and with proper permission all academic activities are to be started in the same premises."

Item 9: Letter from the Secretary of the Governor on the constitution of the advisory Board for the selection of a new Vice-Chancellor.

The Chairperson placed a letter received from the Secretariat of Governor Office and the members discussed the matter in depth. The Executive Council suggested the name of Prof. Alok Kumar Buragohain, former Vice Chancellor of Dibrugarh University as the Executive Council nominee for the advisory board of the selection of the new Vice-Chancellor of Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya due by 23 February 2024. In this context a resolution has been taken as follows:

RESOLUTION NUMBER 39:

"It is resolved that name of Prof. Alok Kumar Buragohain, former Vice-Chancellor of Dibrugarh University is nominated as the member of Advisory Committee for selecting new Vice-Chancellor of Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya, Golaghat, Assam.

Item 10: Any other matter.

(A) Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor proposed that students of Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya should be given uniform as a code of conduct and The Executive Council also accepted that proposal and expressed that a uniform for the students be given after the design is approved by a committee constituted for the same. In this context, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has been entrusted to make it practice. In this context a resolution has been taken as follows.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 40:

"It is resolved that the students of Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya, Golaghat, Assam will be given University as a code conduct."

(B) In case of fees structure, of course if the Govt. of Assam fixes a uniform fees structure, it is to be followed. The Executive Council suggested that the fee structure of Gauhati University be followed by the Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya, Golaghat, Assam. In this context, a resolution has been taken:

RESOLUTION NUMBER 41:


"It is resolved that the University will have to follow the fees structure of Gauhati University for next couple of years."

(C) The Vice-Chancellor placed the letter related to time of commencement of classes and the Executive Council suggested that the classes for the first session start from the 1st week of September, 2023. Of course, it is suggested that the Vice Chancellor may take decision for commencement of Classes from his own considering plight. Further, The executive Council also directed the Vice-Chancellor to follow the ordinances, and rules of Dibrugarh University is necessary for starting academic activities in the University.


