Item No: EC/05/2024/I

To place the proposed Academic Programs under various faculties to be offered from the academic year 2024-25 on Self-financing basis for approval.

The Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya has started its Academic activities from Sept, 2023 at the level of Post Graduate and PhD. The Vishwavidyalaya is now operating MA programmes in Assamese, English, Political Science, Sociology & Economics and PhD programme in Assamese, English, Political Science, Sociology, Economics and Computer Science.

Since, most of the Courses offered by the Vishwavidyalaya at present are Conventional/ Traditional, which have less market demand, as such the Vishwavidyalaya desires to open some specialized Courses on self-financing mode having larger market demand as well as maximum employability as per the guidelines of the Government of Assam. Courses planned to be introduced are extensively interactive and field based, where the experts in the Government Social Institutions and Industries may also join as resource persons.

In this regard, it may be mentioned here that as per the Notice issued on 12/04/2024 by the Directorate of Higher Education, Govt. of Assam the Vishwavidyalaya need to prepare the prospectus with all Course related details by 5th May, 2024 and same is to be uploaded as a PDF file in the admission portal latest by 7th May, 2024.

In view of above in principle, approvals of the Statutory Bodies are required of the Courses to be offered by the University on self-finance basis from the next Academic Session, 2024-2025. Detail Course structure of approved Courses shall be prepared by the respective BoS to be constituted subsequently.

Recommendations of the Academic Council shall be placed during the meeting.

Discussion & Resolution

The Recommendations of the Academic Council pertaining to new Courses proposed to be introduced on self-financing basis from the Academic Session 2024-2025 are placed at ANNEXURE EC/05/01.

R/EC-05/2024/1

The members of the Executive Council discussed in detail and decided to approve in principle the recommendations of the Academic Council regarding proposed Courses to be introduced on self-financing basis at the Vishwavidyalaya with following suggestions:

- 1) Due to limitation of resources being a new University, the Executive Council opined to go for collaborative approach with other nearby Colleges/Universities/Institutes as per the necessity in order to impart proposed Courses smoothly on Self-financing mode.
- 2) The Executive Council suggested to start new Courses on self-financing basis in phase wise as per the need depending on the availability of resources including the number of students opted for admission.
- 3) It was also suggested to explore the possibility to start courses on basic sciences.
- 4) The Executive Council recommended that in no case the quality of teaching learning process in respect of proposed Courses on self-financing basis should be compromised by the University.

The Council appreciated the efforts of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor for the steps taken by him to explore the possibility to introduce new Courses from the Academic

Session 2024-2025 within a very short period after his assuming charge.

The Executive Council also approved regarding submission of undertaking to the Government of Assam by the Birangana Sati Sadhani Rajyik Vishwavidyalaya declaring that the Vishwavidyalaya will not claim for Regularization of Courses/Faculties in future against the Self-Financed Courses proposed to offer by the Vishwavidyalaya in accordance to the Guidelines for Introduction of Self-Financed Courses in the Higher Educational Institutions(HEIs) of Assam.

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor also expressed his gratitude to all esteemed members of the Executive Council and hoped for the continuous help with constructive suggestion in future for the betterment of the University.

As there was no other item, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
